





Method

- Preheat the oven to 170 degrees
- Add the sauce to your tortilla wrap and spread around
- Sprinkle the cheese to cover the tortilla
- Then add your chosen toppings
- Place the tortilla onto a baking tray


Grow your own

Follow the steps below to grow your own seedlings. We've chosen butternut squash, but you can have a go at growing whatever fruit, vegetable or flower you like.

You will need:

- A packet of seeds or the seed from a fruit, vegetable or flower you have around the house
- A small plant pot, or an empty yoghurt pot
- Soil
- An empty plastic bottle
- A trowel

Allow the seedling to grow for a further few weeks and it will then be ready to be moved to a grow bag, or into the garden in a sunny spot. Make sure you water it regularly.



You will need:

- Two or more players
- Each player will need a sheet or a strip of paper and a pen or pencil

How to play


- 1. Each player takes turns in contributing an element to a story.
- 2. Start by writing a boy's name, then fold the paper over to hide your writing and pass the sheet on to the player on your left.
- 3. Then add a girl's name and, again, fold the paper over and pass to the player on your left.

Then add the following:

- Met at [enter a place]
- He said [enter what the boy said]
- She said [enter what the girl said]
- He then [enter what the boy did]
- She then [enter what the girl did]
- And the consequence was [enter what happened]

The text in square brackets above should be replaced with your chosen words and don't forget to fold the paper over and pass to the next person after each step.

When each step is complete, read out the complete story and see which one is the funniest.

You will need


- Squash or fruit juice
- Lolly molds
- Lolly sticks

Method


- Pour your chosen drink into the lolly molds
- Add the sticks
- Place into the freezer until frozen (usually takes 2-3 hours).
- Enjoy

If you don't have any molds, don't worry you could fill an ice cube tray or maybe a small plastic cup.

Why not try some frozen yoghurt, just pop a lolly stick into a full, unopened, yoghurt pot, pop into the freezer and enjoy.







Rocking rock crafts


With a little imagination and some marker pens or paint, you can turn any rock or stone into a work of art.

You will need


- Green Paint or marker

- Clear varnish




1. Paint a green oval




3. Add a smaller tail to the end




5. Once the grey paint has dried, paint on two diagonal lines using black paint for the blades.



2. Next paint the helicopter's tail



4. Once the green paint is dry, paint a grey oval to create the helicopter's windscreen



6. Finally sign off with #TheCrew hashtag. Wait till everything is dry then seal with clear varnish and display with pride!

DIY face mask


Make your own face mask...from a sock!


You may have noticed that lots of people are wearing masks when they are out and about, to help keep themselves and others safe. Did you know that you could make your own out of a sock?




Follow our guide below, but make sure you check with a grown-up before you start.
