FAQS

Categories and nominations

- **How do I submit an entry?** All entries are to be submitted via the Survey Monkey link on the website.
- **Can I submit an entry for more than one category?** Yes. The awards are open to nominate anyone who meets the criteria of the related category. You must submit one entry form for each nomination.
- **Who will be viewing and judging the entries?** We have a high-profile judging panel, who will review the entries and create a shortlist. The winners, which will be revealed on the night.
- **When will I know who the winners are?** The winners will be announced on the evening of awards – Friday 17th September.

Attending the awards

- **What is the date of the event?** Friday 17th September 2021
- **What are the timings for the awards?** 18.30 until 22.00. The after party will commence at the end of the awards.
- **How do I RSVP to the awards?** An invitation and save the date will be sent out via our Events Team with all the details on the event and how to confirm your place.
- **If I can't attend, will you be live streaming the event?** No, there will be no live streaming of this event.
- **I have been shortlisted, but I am unable to attend the evening, what happens if I win?** If you win, we will arrange for your trophy to be presented to you after the event.
- **If I win at the awards on the evening, what will happen?** You will be invited to the stage to collect your award. It will be presented to you by the award sponsor or a representative from The Air Ambulance Service and a photo will be taken of you on stage.

Travel to and from the awards

- **Will I be able to get a hot drink at the event?** Yes, hot drinks will also be available, and refreshments will be served with dessert.
- **What is the menu?** The menu is yet to be confirmed and will be shared this a later date.

General questions

- **How is the charity paying for the awards?** The awards are fully covered by our sponsors. There is no cost to the charity, and this event will be a profit-making event for the charity whilst celebrating everything we have achieved.
