Quick guide on safe fundraising

Hey there #TheCrew member! We're so happy to have you on board and cannot wait to hear about all the exciting things that you have planned. To make sure your fundraising is safe and fun for everyone involved, we've created a quick guide for you with some simple dos and don'ts!

DO



Get creative and have fun!



Wear your #TheCrew members badge when undertaking fundraising activities.



Have a grown-up with you if transporting money from an event or taking it to the bank to pay in.



Pay in or ask your grown-up to transfer all money raised from your event/activity.



Think about the health and safety of yourself and others taking part in your event. The risk assessment guidance and form on our website can help you with this.



If hosting a bake/cake sale ensure that all foods containing nuts, raw eggs, unpasturised milk or other allergens are clearly marked.

DON'T



Undertake any fundraising events without the support or supervision of a grown-up.



Handle money after the event or collect it on your own. Take a grown-up with you and pass it to them straight away.



Don't worry if you need help, the team is here to support you or ask your grown-up.



Go door to door even with a grown-up to ask for donations or sponsorship. This is very dangerous and is also illegal.



Undertake street collections with or without the supervision of a grown-up as it is illegal for children under the age of 16 to take part.



Provide any information about yourself to people you don't know.
