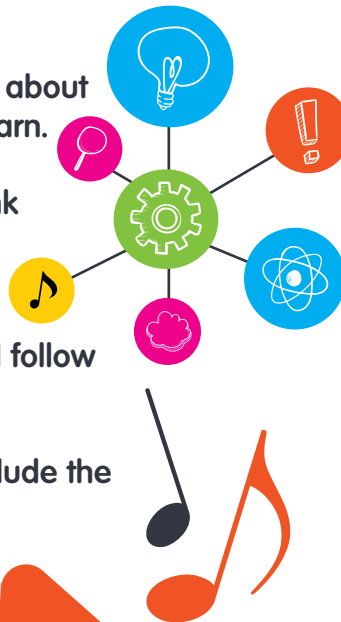


Super song writing tips



Write your song lyrics here

- ★ We have two terrific tunes for you to write your song to – just scan the QR codes on the next page to hear them. The tunes are quite long but your song doesn't have to be as long as these.
- ★ Research what you are going to write your lyrics about and create a mind map, listing the things you learn.
- ★ Writing a song is just like writing a poem, so think of some rhyming words linked to what you have on your mind map and write them down.
- ★ Listen to the tunes lots of times to recognise and follow the patterns of the music.
- ★ Write your verses – these are where you can include the things you have learned during your research.
- ★ Write a chorus – you don't have to do this but it's where you can repeat the most important things you want people to know in your song.
- ★ Listen to the music again and see if the words match the rhythm of the music.
