When six-year-old Edith Dear needed specialist lifesaving care after an emergency operation to remove her appendix, the Children's Air Ambulance flew her to a paediatric intensive care unit 75 miles away.

The transfer team (STRS) arrived on the helicopter while Edith was still in surgery. When she came out of the operating theatre they stabilised her ready for the flight back to London.

"Everyone was very reassuring and explained what was going to happen when she came out of the operation. They answered all our questions and we were relieved to know that she would be in good hands and be taken to the specialist post-operative care she needed as quickly as possible," says Edith's mum Alex.

Could pay for 2,400L of oxygen to be carried on board the Children's Air Ambulance to help critically ill children breathe.

The average cost of a mission is **£3,500** so every penny you raise helps to keep our helicopters in the air.

Whether someone has donated a raffle prize or supported you with running the event - don't forget to say a massive thank you!



KEEP YOUR EVENT SAFE

If you're holding an event you'll need to think about a few things to ensure you're keeping everyone safe.

Insurance - if you are organising an event, be sure it comes under the terms of the school's insurance policy. The Air Ambulance Service will not be liable for any loss or injury arising out of the event or its organisation.

Licences - some things require licences, including alcohol, entertainment or raffles. Contact your local council to find out what is required.

Food Hygiene - if serving or selling food, you need to abide by the Food Standards Agency guidelines. For more information visit:
