First of all, a huge **thank you** for choosing to fundraise for Your Local Air Ambulance. Whether you are supporting us with a one off event or you have chosen us as your Charity of the Year partner, every penny you raise is helping us to keep providing our life saving services.

We fly two local helicopter emergency medical services across Warwickshire & Northamptonshire and Derbyshire, Leicestershire & Rutland. Our doctors, critical care paramedics and pilots could not do their job without the support of people like you. We do not receive any government funding. So on behalf of all of our team, the families whose lives they transform and our patients, thank you for your support.

Fundraising is a great way to support us and in this toolkit you'll find lots of ideas and advice to help you plan activities within your school.

Could pay for pressure dressings to control a patient's bleeding.

Could help buy a stethoscope to help our crew listen to a patient's breathing to see if they have a chest injury.

Schoolboy Jack Simons was airlifted to the Queen's Medical Centre in Nottingham after he was knocked off his bike, dragged under a bus and trapped for over an hour on a busy main road in Leicester.

It took Derbyshire, Leicestershire & Rutland Air Ambulance just seven minutes to fly him to the urgent medical care he needed after the bus was lifted off the ground and Jack was freed.



The 12-year-old had sustained a broken left leg and, luckily, no other injuries despite his horrific ordeal.

His Dad Darren says: "When my son needed help Your Local Air Ambulance was there for him. It could have been a life or death situation but thankfully it wasn't and he was lucky that his injuries weren't more serious."

Could help pay for a special mask that will be used to help patients when they've stopped breathing.

The average cost of a mission is £2,300 so every penny you raise for us helps to keep our helicopters in the air.

Could help pay for an IV kit to allow patients to receive the vital medications they need on scene, including antibiotics or pain relief.

### YOUR FUNDRAISING CHECKLIST




### **SET A DATE**

Give yourself plenty of time to plan your activity and pick a date that best suits your school calendar.




### **SET A FUNDRAISING GOAL**

### **KEEP YOUR EVENT SAFE**



If you're holding an event you'll need to think about a few things to ensure you're keeping everyone safe.

**Insurance** - if you are organising an event, be sure it comes under the terms of the school's insurance policy. The Air Ambulance Service will not be liable for any loss or injury arising out of the event or its organisation.

**Licences** - some things require licences, including alcohol, entertainment or raffles. Contact your local council to find out what is required.

**Food Hygiene** - if serving or selling food, you need to abide by the Food Standards Agency guidelines. For more information visit:
