
I absolutely love a Spring clear-out and now is a perfect time for you to donate vour unwanted clothes and bric-a-brac!



PATIENT STORY

Megan's Story

We never forget the incredible resilience of those we help, and Megan Reeves is a remarkable example. Her story is a powerful reminder of why our lifesaving service exists.

One February morning, 24-year-old Megan, an experienced skydiver with over 300 jumps under her belt, was attempting her first wingsuit jump at Hinton Airfield near Brackley. Wingsuit flying is an exhilarating challenge that uses fabric between the arms and legs to increase lift. But during this jump, a rare sequence of malfunctions led to a terrifying accident.

"Everything that could go wrong did go wrong." Megan recalls. Her parachute didn't open correctly, leaving her spiralling downward at 60mph. Worse still, injuries caused by the failed deployment left her unable to properly operate her reserve chute. With immense effort, Megan managed to open it just 1,000 ft from the ground, but she landed at 50mph, sustaining severe injuries.

Airfield staff raised the alarm immediately, and within 21 minutes of their 999 call, our air ambulance crew were on the scene. Megan had suffered a shattered pelvis, fractures in her lower spine, broken ribs, and serious leg injuries. The severity of her condition required urgent specialist care. Our critical care crew quickly stabilised Megan. Concerned about internal bleeding, the team applied a pelvic binder to limit blood loss and administered medication for clotting and pain relief.

Wrapped in a blizzard blanket for warmth, she was carefully transferred onto a scoop stretcher and airlifted to University Hospital Coventry in just 13 minutes.

Megan spent weeks in hospital undergoing surgery to repair her injuries, followed by extensive physiotherapy and hydrotherapy to learn to walk again. Despite the challenges, her determination never wavered. Amazingly, just over a year after her accident, Megan completed a tandem skydive with a friend. While she approaches her passion for skydiving more cautiously now, she continues to enjoy the sport that changed her life. "Skydiving is an extreme sport, but the safety measures make it low-risk." Megan says. "I had a freak accident, but it hasn't stopped me from doing what I love. I couldn't be more thankful for the air ambulance. I truly believe I wouldn't be alive today if it wasn't for their speed and hard work."

For us, stories like Megan's underline the critical importance of having advanced medical care available at a moment's notice. Our ability to respond rapidly and deliver lifesaving interventions is only possible thanks to the generosity of supporters like you. Megan's story is one of courage, resilience, and gratitude. She inspires us every day and reminds us why our mission matters. Together, we can ensure that people like Megan receive the care they need when it matters most.
